Non-Resident teams-\$525

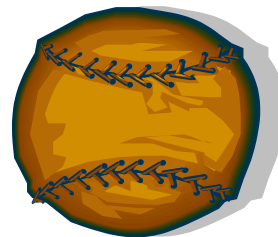
Divisions: Middle and Lower (dependent upon registration)

RULES  
Spring 2012

1. Games will be played at 6:30, 7:30, 8:30, and 9:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Rainouts will be made up at the end of the season before the post season tournament start and/or during the regular season with at least (2) weeks notice. Fridays may be used for make-ups as a last resort, depending on the number of rainouts that occur during the season. The Parks and Recreation Department will determine the schedule. If a game is rained out after five innings are completed, the game will be counted as a complete game. For rain out confirmation the team's coach should contact the Maumelle Parks and Recreation Department at [www.eteamz.com/maumelleadultsoftball](http://www.eteamz.com/maumelleadultsoftball) or call 851-6990 after 3:30 p.m. on game days.
2. A time limit of one (1) hour for each game will be in effect. Time constraints will be strictly enforced. The home plate umpire will be the source for official timing. Coaches are encouraged to calibrate with the official time before game start. The game clock will start upon the home umpire's call for taking the field. Lineups must be submitted to the scoring table 10 minutes prior to the official start time. If lineups are submitted after this 10 minute cut-off, that team will forfeit 3 outs at the start of the game. Lineups must be accurate, including full names and correct numbers for each player. Numbers must be clearly legible on the back of the jersey and only one number, per team, per game can be used. Uniform jerseys are not required. If a team does not have nine players by the start time, the team must forfeit. If the home team is waiting for their tenth player they have the option of becoming the visitor team. Players not on the team roster can NOT be picked up to play. A team is allowed one roster change prior to the 6th played game of the season. This change must be presented by the team's coach to the League Coordinator prior to the game day.
3. Any team that forfeits three (3) games during the season will be eliminated from the league and the league tournament for that season. No refund of fees will be given.
4. No alcohol will be allowed in the softball park including the parking lot and spectator area. Any player having alcohol in the softball park will be ejected from that game and also their next game. No smoking or pets are allowed inside the softball park to include the areas under construction.
5. Any player ejected for any reason will also be suspended from their next scheduled game.
6. All players must bring their driver's license or photo ID to each game. If an individual's I.D. is questioned and the player does not have a valid ID, the player will be ineligible for play. If the player in question has participated in current games when eligibility is challenged, the team will forfeit that game. Ineligible player protests will be handled by the officials at the time of the protest. Roster challenges can be initiated by team coaches, game officials, and MPR staff.
7. Each team must have three (3) game balls ready for the official at all times. The approved ball will be Classic "M", .40 COR, 325 compression.
8. Each batter will start his/her bat with a 1 and 1 count. Players may not use bats outlawed by USSSA. For a list of approved USSSA bats go to [www.ussa.com](http://www.ussa.com).
9. Run rules of 15 after 3, 12 after 4, and 10 after 5 will be enforced. The one-pitch rule will take affect in the event of extra innings and innings played after time expiration.
10. No steel cleats will be allowed.
11. Stealing is allowed once the ball crosses home plate.
12. Courtesy runners are allowed for injured players only within the current game and must be the last out in the lineup from the last inning.
13. Home Run Rules:
  - 1.Pick at the plate-halfway number (rounding down) prevails; 1 to 8 HR's
  - 2.Any fair ball hit over the chain link fence will be considered a home run.
  - 3.Player hitting the home run needs to only touch first base (white or orange).
  4. Any player on base when a home run is hit needs to only touch the next base.
14. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Refer to rule five.
15. Basic USSSA rules will apply outside of the fore-mentioned rules above.
